



AN IMPORTANT REMINDER: BE AWARE OF EMAIL SCAMS



Have you received text messages or emails, from someone claiming to be your

Pastor, Associate Pastor, or a staff member asking for money or gift cards, indicating it is an emergency? Ignore the request! It's not your Pastor or staff. It's a scam! Many parishioners in our Parish and in the Diocese of Calgary have been targeted by this fraudulent behavior. Here's what to know and do:

Your Pastor or Associate Pastor will never contact a parishioner directly with an emergency request for cash or gift cards. Messages asking parishioners to help fulfill a need would come through the Parish or the Diocese official communication channels. If you're not sure about a text or email you've received, do not engage or respond.

Take a screen shot and call your Parish office right away to notify a staff member. In addition, please note that neither your Parish nor the Diocese will ever sell or give away parishioners' personal information.

Often with email messages, a scam can be identified by looking at the email address it was sent from. If it is not an email address you recognize, it's likely a scam.

The Good Shepherd


The readings in today's Mass talk about Jesus the Good Shepherd.


