

### **6TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME**

In our Gospel this week, we are hearing Christ's preaching of the Sermon of the Mount. It is just as much directed to us as Christians today and it is important to know that when Our Lord speaks to us, He sees how we can grow in our relationship with Him and ultimately be saints. Pope Francis reminded us of our call to holiness in one of his exhortations:

"Rejoice and be glad" (Mt 5:12), Jesus tells those persecuted or humiliated for His sake. The Lord asks everything of us, and in return He offers us true life, the happiness for which we were created. He wants us to be saints and not to settle for a bland and mediocre existence. (Pope Francis, Gaudete and Exsultate 1)

As we prepare for Lent, it may be an opportune time to think on what God may be asking of us in the themes of prayer, fasting and almsgiving. Specifically for prayer begin by asking yourself: How is my daily plan of prayer? Does it begin with the Morning Offering and end with an Examination of Conscience? Can extra prayer

time be added, such as praying with Scripture like Lectio Divina? Make our relationship with God a priority and listen to how He may be challenging us to grow.

I was gently led into the Church's music ministry, in Kenya, E. Africa, when my dad gave me a guitar at a very young age. After showing some proficiency on the instrument, my dad got me to accompany him at Mass. After he passed away, a very caring Mary Hill missionary Priest had me accompany him to jails and other exotic locations to many impromptu Masses. My father's gift of the guitar and his faith in me has opened many doors for me and kept me out of trouble from an early age.

I was blessed to be able to continue with this when I came to Canada and played at Holy Trinity Parish before I came to Ascension. I am very fortunate to work with many inspiring and talented choir leaders, who are always encouraging, and supportive and exhort us to do our best for the Lord.
