

### VOLUNTEER ENGAGEMENT MANUAL

The Diocese of Calgary's Volunteer Engagement Manual has been updated and will now be implemented by all the Parishes in the Diocese. This is in line with the standards in 'Strengthening Our Parish Communities' protocols, including screening, training for abuse prevention and reporting.

All volunteers are required to take some training modules in compliance with the updated policies and procedures. The training modules can be done online. It will cover four or more modules depending on the Ministry's level of risk. The goal is to educate everyone who has any kind of leadership or who holds a position of responsibility in the Parish. This includes everyone who works with or around minors, vulnerable adults, and all Church ministries volunteers.

All volunteers will be sent out the link to register online and set up the course. For those who are not able to do the training online, a group session will be conducted in the summer. Everyone is expected to complete the training by the end of fall.
