

Psalm 105: The Lord remembers his covenant forever.

Liturgically, New Year's Day always falls within the Christmas season and since New Year's Day always gives people a sense of optimism and a fresh start, the Church has dubbed it the World Day of Peace.

In 1969, Pope Paul VI restored the ancient Roman practice of celebrating on January 1<sup>st</sup> a liturgical solemnity honoring Mary as the Mother of God. In his Apostolic Letter on Marian devotion, he made a connection between these two dimensions of how the Church welcomes the New Year. He wrote:

"The restored Solemnity of Mary the holy Mother of God... is likewise a fitting occasion for renewing adoration of the newborn Prince of Peace, for listening once more to the glad tidings of the angels, and for imploring from God, through the Queen of Peace, the supreme gift of peace. It is for this reason that, in the happy concurrence of the Octave of Christmas and the first day of the year, we have instituted the World Day of Peace, an occasion that is gaining increasing support and already bringing forth fruits of peace in the hearts of many."

Let us pray for peace in our world on this feast of Mary, Mother of God. Happy New Year!



### What is the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God?

The Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God is a liturgical celebration observed on January 1<sup>st</sup>; it celebrates Mary as the Mother of Jesus and the Mother of the Church.

### Is a solemnity the same as a feast?

Solemnities are special feasts — It is a designation used for certain days within the liturgical calendar of the Church. Solemnities are the highest rank of liturgical celebration, higher than feast days or memorials. By celebrating a solemnity dedicated to Mary's motherhood, the Church highlights the significance of her role in Christ's life.

### The three solemnities which celebrate Mary:

Mary, Mother of God	"She is the Mother of the Head and of the members – the holy Mother of God and therefore the provident Mother of the Church" (January 1 <sup>st</sup> , 2024)
Assumption of Mary	"Recognize the beginning that has already been made and the image of what, for the whole Church, must still come to pass" (August 15 <sup>th</sup> , 2024)
Immaculate Conception	"Recognize the beginning of the Church, the spotless Bride of Christ" (December 9 <sup>th</sup> ,2024)


