


Dear friends,

I think all of us like this Sunday's Gospel. It is easy to apply it to ourselves. Maybe sometimes we act like the first son, sometimes like the second. Who has not promised someone, "I will go and do what you ask," only to leave them stranded, even if it is just by making them wait? And who, on the other hand, has not also had the opposite experience: telling someone that you will not help (maybe because of tiredness, frustration, or a lack of generosity), only to "repent" and lend a hand? At least in my case, after reading this Gospel, I always end up coming to the same conclusion: the best scenario would be to say "Yes" to God with our lips, and then to say "Yes" to God with our actions, too!

If we have that attitude toward God, it will also help us to say "Yes" to others, in word, and in deed.

Bishop McGrattan has asked us to read his new Pastoral Letter next week at Mass. It will help us on our own "Parish Pathway" that we have been speaking about at the beginning of the Sunday Masses.

ONLINE SACRAMENT REGISTRATION IS OPEN

Baptism for Infants: Preparation for Infant Baptism involves registering your child, submitting required paperwork and a Baptism class. The Baptism classes are on the 1st Saturday of each month. Your child's Baptism will be booked after submitting the required paperwork and your participation in the class. Baptisms are celebrated Saturday at 10am and Sunday at 2pm.

FINANCIAL NEWS

Calculations for the month of August show that we had a shortfall of \$16,391 for our operating costs. Operating costs include maintenance, salaries and programs.

Our building fund collection for the month was \$35,481 leaving us with a shortfall on our mortgage payment of \$10,227.

Our monthly mortgage payment is \$46,324
