

CATECHESIS OF THE GOOD SHEPHERD



Ascension Catholic Parish has opened its new **Atrium!** It is a specially prepared classroom for the faith formation of our youngest learners. The Atrium houses handmade materials designed to introduce children to the Catechesis of the

Good Shepherd. On Sept 10th we will host an Open House for you to see the new space after the 10am and Noon Masses.

This fall we will offer two programs in the Catechesis of the Good Shepherd for children ages 4 - 6! Each program includes 12 sessions to help children further their relationship with Jesus and explore key scriptures and aspects of the liturgy.

That Man is You is a program that supports and guides men in their leadership role in society and in the family. It has proven to be a



fundamental support for participants in dealing with the temptations and struggles which challenge their dignity and integrity. The program includes tangible tools to help build a path forward to sustain the grace and growth experienced by participants.

The 13 week program begins on Saturday, September 16th. Sessions start with breakfast at 7:15am. After the breakfast gathering, there will be presentations discussing scientific research, the teachings of the Church and the wisdom of the Saints. Participants will then have the opportunity to discuss the presentations in small groups.

The sessions take one hour and will end by 8:45am, so participants can attend 9am Mass if they wish. This is an opportunity for men to experience God's grace and healing, and learn how they can better serve their wives and families.

A CALL TO SERVICE

MISSIONARY DISCIPLE SPOTLIGHT



My greetings in Christ! My name is Ludvik Vista, and I have been one of Ascension's lead Altar Servers for almost two years now. I am fairly new to the Parish community, yet nevertheless, I was invited very early on to share in the role of the Altar Server ministry during the pandemic in 2021. In many

ways, the Altar Server ministry has served as a catalyst in furthering my ardent faith in our Lord Jesus Christ. Though I am already considerably versed in our faith traditions' doctrines and teachings, it was particularly through this ministry that gave me the fullest opportunity to live out my faith and to see it in a more practical light.

Yet I must admit that prior to coming to Ascension and becoming an active parishioner, I had absolutely no prior knowledge of how Altar Servers conduct themselves, nor had I any sort of background information on what they say or do at Mass. Quite frankly, before I had even put on the vestments for the first time, I completely discouraged myself from Altar Serving. The thought of myself making a mess of things at the Sanctuary or garnering unnecessary attention from the congregation hindered me from joining the ministry. Yet what overcame my hesitancy was the words of my experienced senior Server, who said that these were thoughts that were "...deliberate excuses that prevent me from letting the Lord love you." Now every Mass I serve is but a fulfilling adventure in being immersed in the love of our Lord. Having been a Server for two years, "the best part" of it all is seeing the Lord Jesus being made present in the Blessed Sacrament after the Priest says those beautiful words of consecration.

To be an Altar Server is to partake in this wondrous adventure of self-denial, and total abandonment to God in the Blessed Sacrament. Should anybody have this desire to serve, and maybe because of that, hear a call from our Lord to join the service of His holy Priest-hood — Altar Serving might be your 'step-one' to that. The twentieth chapter of St. Matthew, verse twenty-six, highlights the essence of this ministry, and is coincidentally one of my favorite verses in Scripture: "...whoever wishes to be great among you, must be your servant." As the Altar Server, despite not sharing the same office as the Priest, nevertheless makes himself great through the service of his ministry at the Altar.


